

The frill ends on this Scarf are simple to make and add an interesting effect.



PATTERN RATING:

Easy.

SIZE:

Width:	17cm	[6¾ ins]
Length (approx):	150cm	[59 ins]

YARN REQUIRED:

Approx 200g of a feathery type yarn.
Quantities vary between knitters and types of yarns.

NEEDLES:

A pair of 4.50mm (UK 7, US 7) knitting needles.
Wool needle for sewing in ends.

TENSION:

Tension is not important for this project.

ABBREVIATIONS:

approx = approximately; **beg** = beginning; **cm** = centimetres;
cont = continue; **inc** = increase; **ins** = inches; **K** = knit;
rep = repeat; **stocking st** = knit one row then purl one row;
sts = stitches; **tog** = together.

SCARF

Using 4.50mm needles, cast on 120 sts.

Work 2 rows stocking st.

3rd row: * K2tog, rep from * to end ... 60 sts.

Purl 1 row.

5th row: * K2tog, rep from * to end ... 30 sts.

Cont in stocking st until Scarf measures approx 147cm [58 ins] (or length desired) ending with a purl row.

Next row: Inc knitways in each st ... 60 sts.

Purl 1 row.

Next row: Inc knitways in each st ... 120 sts.

Work 2 rows stocking st, beg with a purl row.

Cast off loosely purlways.

Sew in all ends.
