

This simple, open stitch Scarf is knitted using two strands of 8ply yarn together.

**PATTERN RATING:**

Easy.

SIZE:

Width: 13cm [5 ins]
Length (approx): 150cm [59 ins]

YARN REQUIRED:

Approx 120g of 8ply pure wool yarn.
Quantities vary between knitters and types of yarns.

NEEDLES:

A pair of 8.00mm (UK 0, US 11) knitting needles.
Wool needle for sewing in ends.

TENSION:

Tension is not important for this project.

ABBREVIATIONS:

approx = approximately; **cm** = centimetres; **cont** = continue;
ins = inches; **K** = knit; **patt** = pattern; **pssso** = pass slipped stitch
over; **rep** = repeat; **sl** = slip; **sts** = stitches; **yfwd** = yarn forward.

SCARF

Using 8.00mm needles and yarn double, cast on 17 sts.

1st row: Knit.

2nd row: Knit.

3rd row: K1, * yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, rep from * to end.

4th row: Knit.

Last 4 rows form patt.

Cont in patt until Scarf measures approx 150cm [59 ins] (or length desired), ending with a 4th patt row.

Cast off loosely knitways.

Sew in all ends.
